CODE OF CONDUCTS AND ETHICS POLICY

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PLAYERS:

- Be respectful with your coaches/teammates
- Respect the laws of the game
- Wear your uniform correctly
- Bring your best attitude to each practice/game
- Be a positive leader and a role model for the younger athletes
- Practice good sportsmanship
- Do not use inappropriate language
- Respect team officials and opponents
- Avoid foul play or aggressive behaviour during the games

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR COACHES / CLUB STAFF

- Be respectful with your players and their families
- Be respectful with your peers
- Respect the laws of the game
- Be a role model for your players
- Do not use inappropriate language
- Respect team officials and opponents
- Be on time to all practices and games
- Avoid any personal contact with players and their families (online and in-person)

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PARENTS / GUARDIANS / SPECTATORS:

- No smoking - No alcohol - No swearing is allowed
- Be respectful (zero tolerance policy) to all players, team officials, opponents and their families
- Cheer your kids on in a positive way (negative cheering will not be tolerated).
- Do not coach your kids

HARRASSMENT AND ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY:

First Touch Futbol Club will not tolerate any form of bullying, discrimination, harassment, bad sportsmanship from any member of the Academy (players, coaches, parents, spectators).

The Zero tolerance policy will be applied and the perpetrator can be disciplined up to terminating the player registration.
